RULES & REGULATIONS


- 1. **APPLICATION DEADLINE:** Parade registration MUST be received at the Exhibition Office by Monday, **August 11th, 2024**. Forms can either be emailed or mailed to the address below.
- 2. **INSURANCE:** Proof of liability insurance is mandatory for horses/livestock/oxen and motor vehicles taking part in the parade and must be included with registration form. Your application is considered incomplete until all required paperwork is obtained by the Exhibition Office. Failure to complete your application will result in removal from the parade, regardless of past or current parade history.
- 3. **MAXIMUM DIMENSIONS:** (Float & Tow Vehicle combined) are restricted to 75 ft. long, 8.5 ft. wide and 13 ft. high.
- 4. **PARTICIPANTS:** Absolutely no one can operate a motor vehicle (car, truck, tractor, ATV, etc.) without the proper license. Participants under the age of 10 must be always supervised by an adult at the ratio of 6 children to 1 adult. Participants riding on floats must remain securely seated **or** the perimeter of the float must be surrounded by a secure guardrail. The guardrail must be constructed such that participants cannot easily pass over or through it. The top rail must be a minimum of 1 metre above the walking surface float deck.
- 5. Drivers of the parade entries must have unimpeded vision to the front and sides of the vehicle.
- 6. Entries with trailers or vehicles with a registered weight over 4500 kg must have adult spotters at each axle to keep spectators and participants away from the wheels. The spotters are present strictly for safety purposes and therefore must not be performing parade participants or be engaged in distributing or collecting items along the parade route.
- 7. All motorized or mechanical units should be well finished, clean and in safe working condition. In the event of a mechanical breakdown along the parade route, the entry must be withdrawn from the line-up immediately.
- 8. No entry may depict anything derogatory, controversial, or otherwise offensive.
- 9. Fire/Emergency apparatus are to refrain from using the sirens or horns once they enter the Annapolis Valley Exhibition Grounds. Only short blasts of siren are allowed on the parade route and at the gate entrance to the Main Ring.
- 10. Due to safety concerns, food or other objects cannot be thrown from the floats or vehicles. Walkers may go alongside your entry and hand out directly to the audience.
- 11. Entries should be visibly marked for recognition from all sides.
- 12. Confirmation and position numbers are not sent out to entries. If you require this information prior to the parade, email info@annapolisvalleyexhibition.com



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13. **PARADE ROUTE: Parade entries are to enter Fitch Rd. via Clarence Rd.** Parade route flows from Fitch Rd. onto Main St. and then continues through Exhibition Grounds into the Main Ring for prizes and exits through west end of grounds ending at NSCC COGS school parking area.
